Dear parents, carers and all of our Todmorden High School community.

In reference to last Thursday's event, I, and the staff involved, would like to thank you for your unwavering support of the school. We have been inundated with positive messages, including some from our primary partners. The support from our community has been overwhelming and has meant a lot to the staff and I.

I have been at Todmorden High School for 21 years and a teacher for 36 years and this is the first time in my career that a person has tried to gain entry into the school grounds. School has taken this very seriously. Staff managed to prevent entry into the school buildings and all students and staff were kept safe. No student was under threat.

The matter is now being dealt with by the police. This is why we cannot share the full details.

Together with the company who installed and maintain our systems, we have reviewed our alarm systems and we are planning a second drill of the invacuation for this academic year. Before we do, we will speak to all our children about the precautionary nature of the invacuation and evacuation procedures. As with previous drills we will share the date with you in advance.

Thank you to those of you who have contacted me directly to express your broader concerns. I have spoken with many of you individually and I hope that our conversations, together with the information shared through school communications, have alleviate those concerns.

Have a good weekend, let's hope the weather is as nice as it was last bank holiday weekend.



Our Year 11's have now entered into their examination period.



Study Leave for Year 11



As of Thursday 23rd May, Year 11 students will be given the opportunity to take study leave following their morning English Language exam. Once they have completed their exam, all Year 11 students will be walked off site and will make their own way home. This time will vary slightly from student to student depending on their exam access arrangements, however the exam is due to be 1 hour 45 minutes.

We are currently putting together a number of revision sessions for any outstanding exams following the May Half Term. As soon as this has been finalised, we will publish this with all students, parents and carers.

Students should the proceed to follow the procedure below during the final weeks of exams:

For morning exams

Students should continue to come in as they usually would from 8:20 where toast and bagels will be available in the dining room.

For afternoon exams

For exams beginning at 13:00, students should arrive on site at 12:45 and wait at the benches at the front of school.

For exams beginning at 13:30, students should arrive on site at 13:15 and wait at the benches at the front of school.

If students require a school lunch before an afternoon exam, then they should arrive at 12:20 and join the queue in the dining room.

For revision sessions (which will be confirmed shortly)

Students should sign in at reception using the inventory system. They must sign out using the same system too as and when they leave site. The ambition shown by our students so far has been commendable. Even though the end of the exam season can be incredibly stressful and overwhelming for students, it is crucial that they continue to work hard to allow them to achieve their unique potential.
