



Relationships, Sex Education and Health Education

One of the changes for next academic year (2020-2021) is new government guidance with regard to the teaching of 'Relationships, Sex and Health Education'. There is an increase in content that secondary schools have to make sure they cover, spread out over the five years of secondary. Depending on the nature of the content, things may be taught earlier or later during the secondary phase, for example, lessons on friendships might be taught in lower key stage 3 whereas lessons about sexual health will be taught in key stage 4.
