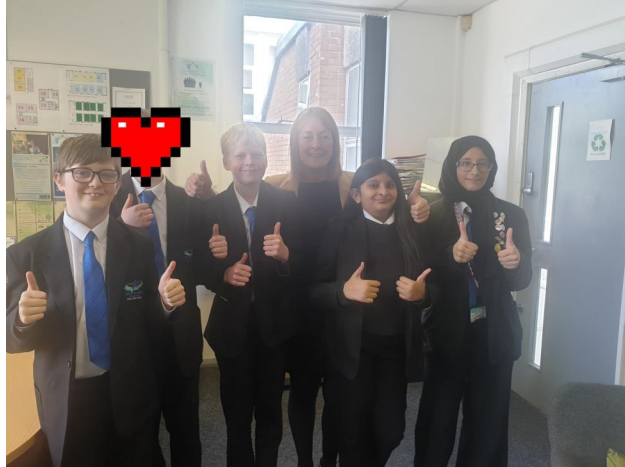
School filming
